The Friends have made it possible for our community to enjoy a beautiful, fun and free space for learning, creating and playing. Come check out our programs, services and materials that we are sure you will love!



In 2004 The Friends of the Lomira Public Library was formed. The group's initial purpose was to raise funds for the new library building.

The new building was dedicated in 2011 as the Lomira QuadGraphics Community Library. The Friends organization has now expanded its activities.

Though basic operating expenses for the library are met by portions of the village budget, many aspects of a vibrant public library are dependent on volunteers and private donations.

These needs include capital equipment, supplies, program underwriting and the supportive energy that invigorates our civic culture.

The Friends of the Lomira QuadGraphics Community Library is dedicated to serving Lomira and its surrounding areas in these ways.

Frequently Asked Questions

What do the Friends do exactly?

The Friends of the Lomira QuadGraphics Community Library is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization committed to activities that support the library. It is 100% responsible for the capital campaign that made our beautiful library a reality.

When are the meetings?

The Friends of the Library meets quarterly – Please check out the library events calendar online, the Facebook page and/or the library website for updates. You can also call the library for more details.

Do I have to join?

You can come to any Friends meeting and hear what it's all about without joining.

How do I join?

You may pay your Friends dues at your first membership meeting. Dues are \$10 per year for individuals. A lifetime membership may be purchased for \$100.

Can I support the Friends without attending the meetings?

YES!!! Here are just some of the other ways you can support the library:

- **You may donate gently used books to be put out for sale; proceeds are used to buy new materials.
- **You may bring in your receipts from Lomira Piggly Wiggly; the library gets a percentage of all receipts.
- **You may check out the library's wish list on the website; it has specific needs listed.
- **You may make an outright monetary donation to either the Friends or the Library.
- **You may buy a brick for around the circulation desk of the library. Each brick is only \$75 and may serve in honor or in memory of a person or event.
