Volunteer with the Friends!

Under the direction of the Library Board of Trustees and the Library Director, The Friends of the Lomira Library exists to support library activity and material needs which fall outside tax-payer funded operational expenses. The Friends group is a separate, not-for-profit entity which, among other things, sponsors programs, holds fund-raisers, and "shops" for fun things the library requests. Ways to Participate:

- **Friends Meeting Attendee:** Folks who want to be "in on things" with routine briefings from the Library Director and Friends leaders are invited to attend any and all Friends meetings which are usually held bi-monthly. Membership is not required for attendance.
- **Friends Member/Leader:** Join the group formally. Hold an office or be the point-person for a fundraiser.
- **Wish-List Coordinator:** Though the Friends sometimes donate money to the library, many items are donated "in kind." When the Library Director presents a "wish list" of items he/she feels would enhance the library, the Friends assess the request and assign a member to research and plan purchases on behalf of the group.
- **Marketing Coordinator**: This Friends member coordinates the Friends section of the library website, Facebook page, brochures, posters and any other public view of the group.
- **Baker Cookies/Bars:** Home-made bars and cookies are needed for the bi-annual Election Day Bake Sale. These sales are conducted on Presidential and mid-term election days, basically every other year. This job consists of baking and donating a batch of bars or cookies.
- **Baker Pies:** Home-made pies are needed for the concession stand at the annual Fond du Lac Symphony band concert in the park. This job consists of baking and donating a pie for the concert evening which is usually in mid-August on a Thursday.
- Activities Aide: "Worker Bees" are needed at Friends-sponsored programs and fund-raisers. Some examples:
 - o "Sherlock Assistant" at the History's Mysteries contest
 - Concession stand worker at the August band concert
 - o Election Day Bake Sale clerk
 - o Lights of Love set-up crew member
