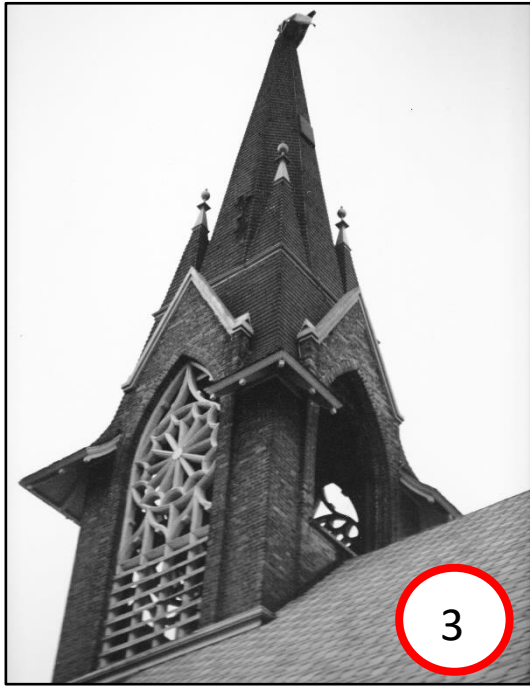


Sample Puzzle



Five of the photos show the aftermath of a tornado that struck the Lomira area on Apr 21, 1974. One picture shows a streetlight pole and lights bent by the storm in the parking lot of what was then the Brasch Piggly Wiggly store and what is now the Damark Company. Picture 2 shows a view of the American Legion Hall and damage to the overhead bridge. Damage is shown to the top-most point of St. John's steeple and the home of Martin and Marcella Enderle. Picture 6 shows destruction at the corner of Highways 175 and 49. The Gindt barn (right side of photo) was leveled. On the left side of Picture 6, one sees damage to what was then "Club 49" and what is now Rock the House.
